FEVER NATION bumped with an outer foe at the start, tracked inside, was driven along the rail around the turn, angled out to the four path to bid at the top of the lane, took command going into the final furlong, kicked on to draw clear around the sixteenth, and held firm. JUNIOR BUG raced off the pace in the five path, improved while being coaxed along in the four path around the turn, fanned out to the seven path turning into the stretch, angled back into the five path, then ran on to get up for place around the sixteenth. DUST DANCER set the pace inside, was coaxed along around the turn, stayed on from the two path in upper stretch, but faded in the final furlong. SPANISH DOUBLOON bumped with an inner foe at the start, was prompted from up close in the two path, ridden around the turn, floated out to the five path at the top of the lane, but weakened. YOU'RE IN COREY bumped with an inner foe at the start, was well back in the four path, floated out to the seven path entering the stretch, and made no closing bid. RED LABEL bumped with an outer foe at the start, stalked in the three path but gave way from the six path down the lane, bled, and walked off.
