BAD OBSESSION prompted the pace between foes in the two path early, was ridden along the inside around the turn, floated out to the five path in upper stretch, and rallied in the final furlong to draw ahead in the final strides. SNEAKY FEET broke well and dueled with an inner foe in the three path, was ridden around the turn, continued to duel gamely on the left lead down the stretch, led into the final sixteenth, but was overtaken by an outer foe in the final strides. LUCKY DESTINY vied for the lead inside, was cued midway around the turn, dug in from the two path down the stretch, but got edged out by an outer pair in the final furlong. DON'T TELL KIM trailed in the four path, angled to the rail entering the turn, then angled back out passing the quarter, fanned out to the six path into the stretch, and kept on to pass tired inner rivals. TUFF HEART stalked in the four path, was driven in the three path around the turn, but faded from the four path down the stretch. RAGNOW tracked between foes from the three path into the turn, was driven from the two path into the stretch, but weakened. PARAYKO chased in the five path, was ridden along in the four path around the turn, but did not threaten.
