EERIE'S SONG attended just off and inside the early leader, moved forward to take command past the seven-sixteenths, drew off in upper- to mid-stretch then held safe. I'M THISTY KID switched out and advanced outside runners four to five on the turn, was forced wider still fanning eight wide into upper stretch, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. DANDY RUBY chased from inside, moved out near the quarter pole, kept on in the stretch to get up for show late. WEDDING IN COMO exchanged bumps at the start, was off the pace outside advancing four wide through the turn, shifted in a bit in mid-stretch, ran on inside. STORMY ATTACK chased outside going three wide on the turn, weakened in the stretch. WARSHIN MACHINE was bumped between runners at the start, outpaced early, swung seven wide, was not a factor. CITIZEN EX bumped a rival hard at the start, chased from between runners in the second group, dropped back at the half, faded thereafter. CHIEF GROSS got away alertly setting the pace from off the rail, retreated and came up empty.
