SHADY MCGEE (IRE) settled inside off the pace, switched off the rail up the backstretch, took closer order in the two path on the far turn, angled five to six wide turning for home, drove clear then held. OUR HEAVENLY GIFT set the early tempo from inside, was embroiled in a battle early up the backstretch, took back passing the nine-sixteenths and switched out early on the far turn going three then four wide, fanned seven wide into upper stretch, kept on and was second best. NIGHTWIND exchanged incidental contact at the start, was strongly urged forward but caught six then five wide into and on the first turn, attended the pace from outside, moved to a brief and narrow lead at the seven-sixteenths, vied between foes late on the far turn, kept on in the stretch to get third. LUCKY DESTINY stalked just off the leaders three wide on the first turn, advanced four then three wide on the far turn, bid at the quarter pole, weakened in the final furlong losing show honors late. REGIMENTAL lacked early speed trailing while racing off the inside, swung seven wide into upper stretch passing tired rivals. ANCIENT MAN settled into stride off the pace near but removed from the rail in the two to three path, swung five wide into upper stretch, was never near enough to threaten. TRUIST stalked the leader on the first turn then moved closer to vie between runners from the five-eighths, dueled inside on the far turn, faltered in the lane. HIGHLY PERFECT was caught five wide into the first turn easing back and switching out wider still, steadily dropped back, moved nearer but still off the rail for the far turn, swung nine wide into upper stretch, failed to menace. STRONGER TOGETHER took back and angled in entering the first turn racing two wide, was closer inside on the far turn but had no response when asked.
