BILL'S HONOR gained the lead in the opening quarter mile, held his advantage on the turn and dug in gamely under steady right-handed pressure to prevail. COOLTHING reserved while five wide, advanced on the turn, continued five wide into the stretch and rallied. RHODIUMS PRIDE contested the early pace, stalked on the turn, urged at the quarter pole, angled in at the sixteenth pole and stayed on. PONTUS raced in striking position while three wide, moved four wide into the stretch and had no rally. VERRAZANOINTHESKY saved ground in the rear early and was never involved. ON THE MONEY RED was outpaced while five wide and did not factor.
