## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SOLOMON VANDY tracked the pace setter three wide into the turn, in pursuit same three deep placing leaving the quarter pole, drew even outside the leader leaving the furlong marker, kicked away under steady guidance. SKYLANE broke a step slow, raced off the pace three wide around the bend, put to task four deep through the lane, rallied late for the place. PONTUS saved ground off the pace, clean rail bid started from the quarter pole, chased on willingly to nail down the show prize. EL PELIGRO quickly clear into the turn, collared by outside rival approaching the furlong marker, running on the wrong lead, faded through the final stages. MERLOTTI slow start, roused off the and off the rail into the lane, never threatened.
