LAST CALL GENO off slowly, stalked the pace near the inside, continued its inside run through the far turn into lane and finished well to draw clear under steady pressure. RICHOCHET RICK set all the pace along the inside, well clear into the upper stretch but was no match for the winner through the drive. TAP THE PRIZE broke awkwardly, raced near the back after the poor start, raced five wide into the upper stretch and had not enough for the top pair. ALLKINDSOFTROUBLE urged along early, raced two to three wide through the far turn and raced evenly with no closing run. STORMYSTORMYNIGHT dropped back early, ridden along three wide through the far turn and had no responses. AMERICAN BLEND stalked the pace and tired while racing near the inside. DAN B raced far back and never threatened.
