NANDINA stalked the pace racing three-wide, moved up to take the lead nearing the quarter pole and quickly drew clear. BEE BLUFF was off a step slow then reserved early, rallied three-wide into the stretch and finished strongly. CHANCE TAKER vied with TOO MUCH TUESDAY from along the inside and held on fairly well for third. TOO MUCH TUESDAY vied with CHANCE TAKER for the lead from along the outside and finished well in a steady effort. STEAL POETIC saved ground while being unhurried and failed to seriously threaten. DESSERT FIRST was two-wide racing in the middle of the field early and weakened. LIT MISS HAT TRICK was allowed to settle racing three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and tired.
