ROSE OF MOONCOIN broke alertly, showed good speed and drew to a clear lead heading into the turn, set decent fractions while well handled and a bit off of the rail approaching the quarter pole, drew clear while in hand nearing the furlong marker, felt a bit of pressure from the runner-up into the final sixteenth and kept to task in the late stages. TAMARANDO COAST stalked the solid early pace, gained ground into the turn and chased the pacesetter two to three wide nearing the quarter pole, was outkicked into the stretch, re-rallied into the final sixteenth, was gaining on the winner in deep stretch but could not reel that one in and was second best. NICE ENCOUNTER raced close up to the solid early pace, saved ground into the turn and made a mild gain at the quarter marker, maintained an inside path into the stretch, could not match strides with the top two heading into the final sixteenth and held for third at the finish. FLY SOUTH a bit slow away from the start, was allowed to settle in the early stages, improved position three wide along the turn, was outrun into the stretch, mildly re-rallied in the final sixteenth but needed more. ADJUST THE HEAT allowed to settle in the early running, raced between rivals into the turn, was guided four to five wide into the stretch and did not threaten. VALERIE chased the solid early pace from the inside, ran in pursuit to the quarter marker, could not keep pace into the stretch and gave way.

RIMPROTECTOR broke a step slow then bid for the lead but drifted out a bit away from the gate, exchanged a light bump with PASSARANDO, allowing ROYAL N RANDO to slip through on the rail and grab the lead, followed that latter foe through the turn then tracked a length or two behind down the backstretch, went to bid for the lead from the five-sixteenths marker, took a short lead into the stretch with MOBOU making a run on the inside, put that rival away in deep stretch then just held off a fast closing PASSARANDO to prevail. PASSARANDO took a bump from RIMPROTECTOR before the first turn when that rival started to drift out going into the turn, then tracked three wide down the backstretch, moved into contention from the three furlong pole but became boxed in as the field turned into the stretch, altered course out a path in mid-stretch, responded to strong handling and intermittent urging, surged late and just missed. LOVE CANDY got caught five wide into the first turn then raced at the back of the compact field down the backstretch, circled the field on the far turn to get into contention, came five wide into the stretch and finished well under a strong hand ride to gain the show. MOBOU was forced out four wide by RIMPROTECTOR going into the clubhouse turn, was held up under a long hold down the backstretch and tracked mid-pack, was let loose going into the far turn but lacked room, idled inside to the stretch, squeezed through a narrow opening between horses near the three-sixteenths pole, battled RIMPROTECTOR to deep stretch then weakened passing the sixteenth pole. ROYAL 'N RANDO broke well and was first to the turn, opened up through the turn then tried to slow down the pace, was allowed to set a moderate pace with constant pressure from RIMPROTECTOR who was always close, held the lead to the far turn, then fought back when beset by a host of challengers from the five-sixteenths pole then weakened in mid-stretch.

AURATIUM off a step slowly, was hustled in the early stages and raced close up into the first turn, saved ground into the backstretch run, advanced to vie for the lead at the half-mile marker and battled ANN LOVES MARK into the second turn, shook free of that runner nearing the quarter marker and extended the lead into upper stretch, was kept to task under moderate urging into the final sixteenth, felt a bit of pressure from oncoming rivals in deep stretch and held safely for the win at the finish. THEA hesitated at the start and was away slowly, was unhurried in the early going and saved ground into the backstretch run, advanced while saving all of the ground into the second turn, checked while in a bit tight nearing the quarter pole, maintained an inside path into the stretch and improved position at the furlong marker, was gaining into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and held well in the end for place honors. CATALINA COCKTAIL tracked the early pace three wide into the first turn, well placed into the backstretch run, was floated four to five wide entering the far turn and chased while widest nearing the quarter pole, re-rallied in the drive and just missed for second at the finish, while clear of the rest for third. OUTRAGEOUS forwardly placed away from the start, attended to the early pace two wide along the first turn, stalked the decent pace between runners into the backstretch, chased three wide into the far turn, shifted to the rail and ran in pursuit of AURATIUM into upper stretch, could not find a response in the final sixteenth and weakened in deep stretch. CANDY LITZ allowed to settle while never far back early on, raced two to three wide along the first turn, was unhurried through the backstretch run, lost ground into the far turn and did not factor in the stretch. ANN LOVES MARK stumbled leaving the start but was away in good order, assumed early command and set decent fractions into the backstretch, was confronted nearing the half-mile marker by AURATIUM and battled that rival into the second turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker, dropped back into the stretch and tired in the final furlong.

LAMMAS (GB) allowed to settle while not far back in the early going, was guided two wide along the first turn, gained ground into the backstretch run and tracked the decent pace between runners approaching the half-mile marker, ran in pursuit two to three wide nearing the quarter pole, roused four wide into the stretch, responded to urging past the furlong marker and rallied into the final sixteenth, surged in deep stretch and got up in the final strides for a determined win. AIR FORCE RED broke alertly and assumed command away from the start, set decent fractions while well handled through the backstretch run, was pressed by ASTRONOMER into the second turn then repelled that rival into upper stretch, dug in while under pressure approaching the final

sixteenth, drifted out a path inside of the sixteenth-pole, met the bid of LAMMAS in deep stretch and was tagged for the win in the final strides. BALNIKHOV (IRE) unhurried in the early going, saved ground into the backstretch run, maintained an inside path into the far turn and mounted a rail rally into the stretch, gained ground at the furlong marker, finished well into the final sixteenth and just missed for the win and place. ASTRONOMER prominent away from the start, stalked the solid pace from a two wide path along the first turn, attended to the decent pace through the backstretch run, advanced into the second turn and pressed AIR FORCE RED nearing the quarter pole, battled for the lead into the lane then lost a bit of ground at mid-stretch, came in tight into the final sixteenth when AIR FORCE RED drifted out and was outfinished in deep stretch. IL BELLATOR close up in the early going, saved ground into the first turn, well placed while saving all of the ground into the far turn, chased the leaders to the quarter marker, advanced into the stretch, could not find the needed late response and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. SUMTER allowed to settle while never far back in the early running, raced three wide along the first turn, well placed through the backstretch run, chased three wide into the far turn, ran evenly to mid-stretch, rallied in the final sixteenth but needed more. FREEPORT JOE settled along the inside into the first turn, guided two wide into the far turn, offered a mild late rally but could not threaten the leaders in the final stages. CATHKIN PEAK (IRE) unhurried in the early going, settled two wide into the first turn, improved position three wide into the far turn but could not sustain that run into the stretch. I'M A GAMBLER (IRE) allowed to settle away from the start, went three wide into the first turn, was guided two wide into the far turn and did not factor. I'M GONNABESOMEBODY settled off of the early pace, trailed into the far turn and raced three wide to the quarter pole, swung widest for the stretch drive and did not threaten. CLOVISCONNECTION forwardly placed in the early stages, tracked the solid pace three wide into the first turn, well placed along the backstretch run, chased three to four wide into the second turn, dropped back in upper stretch and gave way in the final furlong.

HAPPY CHAPPY broke sharply and took the early lead in hand, was pressed to the outside by SWIFT NATALIE with the rest in close pursuit, was confidently ridden through the turn then responded when set down passing the three-sixteenths pole, finished strong under steady handling held safely in deep stretch to prevail. LEEDSTHESKY broke out and bumped into AGELESS UNION, settled into stride mid-pack through the early stages, was a threatening presence through the turn while waiting for room, split horses near the quarter pole then set out after HAPPY CHAPPY on the lead, was gaining into the final sixteenth and bested the rest. AGELESS UNION broke awkwardly then was bumped by LEEDSTHESKY, angled out to the five path for the run down the backstretch, made a little forward progress racing four wide through the turn, then swung five wide into the stretch and closed well to gain the third placing. ALMOST GOT LUCKY reluctant to load, steadied at the break when SWIFT NATALIE came over at the start, then rushed up to race just behind the leaders near the half-mile pole three to four wide and continued that path through the turn, came under a stiff ride from the three furlong pole while launching a bid for the lead, was four wide of five horses across the track turning for home, had a little trouble changing leads in the stretch and was unable to find another gear when needed. SWIFT NATALIE broke out and into the path of ALMOST GOT LUCKY, then raced close up behind the pacesetter, bid between horses as five contenders fanned out across the track from the quarter pole, was outkicked at the furlong marker and weakened in deep stretch. KISSES WITH ROSES broke well but dropped back to last before the turn, stayed to the inside through the turn and encountered traffic at the quarter marker, found room into upper stretch, could not muster a response into the final furlong and did not threaten.
