MAJESTIC GIG broke sharply but was content to let the pace scenario play out in the early stages, started an extended bid from the half mile pole, went three wide through the turn, pulled nearly even with BLURSDAY at the top of the stretch, battled that stubborn foe to deep stretch, briefly took the lead but was passed late by the winner. BLURSDAY was hustled out of the gate, brushed with BOB'S VAI, seized the early lead with BOB'S VAI pressing the issue to the inside, put that one away after three furlongs then immediately took on a new challenge from MAJESTIC GIG, dueled that one to deep stretch and gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. LITTLE LILIANA broke in at the start and bothered BOURBON GLAZE, steadied, then raced near the back in the early going, moved four wide into contention after passing the half mile, pole, bid three wide around the turn, loomed a threat passing the quarter pole, finished well but could not make an impact. BOURBON GLAZE got squeezed at the start and had to steady, then was hard ridden to regain contact with the field, made a mild gain on the turn but could not sustain the bid and was no factor down the stretch. BOB'S VAI broke out at the start and brushed with BLURSDAY then was pushed to get forward position, was able to secure the rail and press BLURSDAY through solid early fractions, started to weaken approaching the three furlong pole and was unable to keep up late.

SARK broke alertly and assumed command away from the start, set the pace into the first turn and dictated terms into the backstretch run, carved out moderate fractions nearing the half-mile marker, was pressured into the second turn by BRAVO RAGAZZO and battled that rival into the stretch, lost the lead past mid-stretch and stubbornly stayed on into the final sixteenth, yielded in deep stretch and was outfinished for second, while just holding for third. GOODBYE DAL allowed to settle in the early stages, raced four wide into the first turn, maintained an outside path into the backstretch run and was well placed while widest at the half-mile, mounted a five wide bid at the quarter marker, could not sustain that run into the stretch drive and flattened out. DUNGARVAN OAK was forwardly placed leaving the start, raced close up to the early pace and tracked three wide along the first turn, well placed through the backstretch run, mounted a three to four wide bid approaching the quarter marker, was outkicked into the stretch and weakened in the final stages. SEA OF LIBERTY away from the gate in good order, raced close up to the early pace and saved ground into the first turn, tracked the decent pace through the backstretch run and was well placed approaching the half-mile marker, saved ground into the far turn, was taken off of the rail and asked for run two to three wide nearing the quarter marker, loomed into upper stretch and took command heading to the furlong pole, was set down at mid-stretch and met the bid of WELLSWORT into the final sixteenth, dueled the game runner-up to deep stretch and determinedly prevailed in the final strides. WELLSWORT (IRE) allowed to settle away from the start, was guided two wide into the clubhouse turn and was unhurried through the backstretch run, saved ground into the far turn and was roused at the quarter marker, maintained an inside path into the stretch and was full of run nearing the furlong pole, vied for the lead at mid-stretch and battled SEA OF LIBERTY into the final sixteenth, dueled the determined winner to deep stretch, was gamely bested in the final strides and just held for second at the finish. ORIGINAL was prominent leaving the start, rated nicely off of the early pace and saved ground into the first turn, was unhurried through the backstretch run and saved ground nearing the half-mile, roused two to three wide into the far turn, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and rallied at the furlong pole, responded to urging into the final sixteenth and closed fast into deep stretch, surged in the final strides and just missed for the win and place, while holding safely in the end for the show honors. IMPLICITLY was allowed to settle in the early running, saved ground into the first turn, was reserved through the backstretch run and was quided two wide into the second turn, angled widest for the stretch drive and advanced at

the furlong marker, closed willingly into the final sixteenth but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. J T'S WATCH was crowded a bit leaving the start and was away from the gate a step slowly, was unhurried in the early going and saved ground into the first turn, was content to trail along the backstretch run, saved all of the ground into the far turn and improved position at the quarter marker, rallied at mid-stretch, needed more into the final sixteenth and found his best stride late. STRAIT OF GEORGIA hustled away from the start, vied for the early lead then ceded the front to MACHO CHROME, stalked the decent pace into the backstretch run and was well placed approaching the half-mile marker, chased four to five wide into the second turn and advanced at the quarter marker, ran evenly to mid-stretch and could not muster the needed response in the final sixteenth. MACHO CHROME broke a step slowly leaving the start, rushed up in the early going and assumed command into the first turn, set a decent early pace and carved out solid fractions approaching the half-mile, showed the way into the second turn and held a clear lead at the quarter pole, came under pressure into upper stretch and battled to the furlong marker, was overtaken past mid-stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. LORD WIMBORNE (IRE) was allowed to settle, raced two to three wide along the first turn, unhurried through the backstretch run, was guided outside of rivals and raced five wide nearing the quarter marker, offered a mild response in the stretch drive but did not factor. ITS THIEVERY was prominent away from the start, vied for the early lead and stalked the pace into the first turn, chased MACHO CHROME through solid fractions nearing the half-mile marker, ran in pursuit while three to four wide and between rivals nearing the quarter pole, lost position into the stretch and tired in the final stages. MELANIE'S TIGER veered out at the start and forced CLEVER CLOVER into the adjacent path, then lagged well behind the field for the first quarter mile, made a mid-race move through the far turn circling field, swung seven wide into the stretch and produced a bold rally to be up in time despite drifting out a bit. NAFTIS got squeezed a bit at the start, recovered and tracked as the inside horse of the three chasing the pacesetter, was set down with three furlongs to run and responded, pulling even with the leader at the top of the stretch, going clear approaching the furlong grounds then was caught and passed in the final yards. HALO RANDO raced mid-pack four wide down the backstretch, started to advance from the half-mile pole and continued wide through the turn, swung out to the six path for the stretch run and finished well under steady handling to gain third, well clear of the next horse. VALIANT SON raced on the outside of a trio chasing the early leader, struggled to keep up when the pace quickened near the three furlong pole, got stuck behind horses in upper stretch and lost momentum, got clear late but could not find the needed late response. REGAL REDWOOD raced between horses chasing the early leader,

was put into a drive from the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch three wide, loomed a threat but could not find the needed response and finished evenly. CLEVER CLOVER broke out slightly but made light contact with NAFTIS, tracked from close range inside, became boxed in through the turn, had trouble finding clear run in the stretch but was unable to quicken when needed in deep stretch. EIGHT CLAP broke in at the start and made contact with NAFTIS, was outrun early then raced near the back of the pack down the backstretch, came under a ride before three furlongs were run, advanced into the stretch but could not sustain that run in the late stages and did not factor. GOOD LOVIN rocketed out of the gate and went clear early, held sway to the quarter pole, fought back briefly when beset by challengers at the quarter pole then tired in the stretch.
