REAL MACHO was close up early on the outside, then went on and drew clear to show the way to the half mile marker while remaining on the outside, five path on the turn and came six wide into the lane and was headed nearing the furlong marker and dug in gamely and won the bob to prevail under a drive. DAI VERNON pressed the early pace on the inside and then tracked the loose leader towards the inside and raced in the three path on the turn, came four wide into the lane to make a bid and dueled with the winner the final furlong but missed losing the bob. BROOKLYN GUY chased the early slow pace, raced in the three to four path on the turn and came five wide into the lane and loomed by the furlong marker and angled out for racing room inside the furlong grounds and was gaining late. SPEAK EASY set the early pace under a hard hold and then leaving the eleven sixteenths was pulled up and moved towards the outside rail, ran on on the far turn and was finally pulled up in the lane and walked off.
