FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, March 15. \$1,375 to enter. A \$150 supplement may be made at time of entry. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. *(\$25,000 to the owners of a registered Florida-bred divided \$17,500 to the winner, \$5,000 to second, \$2,500 to third). . Weight: 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on turf since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; such a race in 2025 or a stakes race on turf since August 1, 4 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners in 2025-26, graded stakes-placed in 2025-26, non-restricted stakes winners in 2025-26, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the Tapeta Course at One Mile and One Sixteenth) (Rail at 59 feet).

SWEET REBECCA had early speed inside, rated back entering the first turn, was hard held inside while fighting the rating, edged closer at the rail around the far turn, got through inside in upper stretch, quickly cleared and held safe late under mild urging. HANG THE MOON saved ground well off the pace, rallied at the rail, tipped two wide near the sixteenth pole and finished strongly to just miss. MAGGIE GO (ARG) saved ground in midpack, tipped out in upper stretch and rallied for the show. QUEENS COMMAND (IRE) raced in range two and three wide, swung six wide turning for home and ran on for a share. OLIVIA VALENTINA was off a bit slowly, trailed inside, angled three wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly between foes. YES IT TIZ failed to menace while racing three wide. SILVER MOONLIGHT set the pace along the rail, drifted out turning for home, drifted again near the sixteenth pole and weakened. ASHIMA tracked the pace three wide, bid near the quarter pole, was floated out in upper stretch then was bumped and taken in hand near the

sixteenth pole. CANDY QUEST pressed the pace two wide, was floated out turning for home, was forced out and bumped near the sixteenth pole and had no further bids. FANTASY PERFORMER saved ground off the pace, went three wide around the far turn and never threatened.
