STAKES FHBPA Fillies and Mares Turf S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FLORIDA BRED FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, April 11. \$875 to enter.

A \$100 supplementary nomination may be made prior to closing time of entries. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 126 lbs. Non-winners of a stakes race at one mile or over since May 1, 2025 allowed 2 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance since October 1, 2025, 4 lbs; two such races since then, 6 lbs.

Starters to be named by usual time of closing. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. Preference will be given to stakes winners, stakes placed, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off the turf it will be run on the Tapeta course at a distance of One Mile and Seventy Yards. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the Tapeta Course at One Mile and Seventy Yards) (Rail at 38 feet). (S)

SOUPER ZONDA was well rated three wide and made a three wide bid leaving the turn and slowly edged clear in the furlong grounds to prove best under a drive. DREAMING OF ABBA was allowed to settle early two wide, came under coaxing two to three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and finished well gaining the place award late. MISS MARY NELL pressed the pace and made a two wide bid by the quarter pole and gained a short lead leaving the three sixteenths and then was out-finished losing the place award late. ASHIMA taken back on the rail early, eased out on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and had a late rally to gain the last spot in the superfecta on the wire. NOTABLE EXCHANGE was allowed to settle early two wide, advanced three to four wide on the far turn and came five wide into the lane and had a mild late kick. SHESHIMAINTENANCE was fractious in the gate,

settled early on the inside and came four wide into the lane, angled in leaving the furlong marker but flattened out. CHARLIE'S WISH was settled back early, made a four to five wide run on the far turn and came six wide into the lane but lacked the needed kick. LETS GO KOKO was rated along the inside and saved ground on the far turn but weakened in the lane. NINA'S LAST GIFT set a pressured pace on the inside and was headed nearing the quarter pole and weakened and then eased the final sixteenth, walked off.
