OUTLAW COUNTRY pressed the pace four wide on the first turn, then made a two wide bid on the far turn and gained a short lead leaving the five sixteenths and then shook clear leaving the turn and then remained clear to the wire to prove best. DIXIE PREACH was rated along the rail early, eased off the inside on the far turn and made a three wide bid leaving the turn but hung late while saving the place award. NEVER SAY NEVER pressed the pace three wide on the first turn, then rated back and was two to four wide on the far turn, then finished willingly but needed more late. FLAG OFFICER was settled early two to three wide, then moved out and was four to five wide on the far turn and came six wide into the lane but had no late punch while racing one paced. MANHATTAN BOY set a pressured pace on the inside while in the two path, dropped to the rail and dueled with the winner by the three eighths marker and then tired in the drive. JONNY QUIST was reserved early and failed to menace.
