RAYDAR CONTROL got pinched at the start, raced off the pace in the five path, ranged up in the four path around the turn, bid passing the quarter, led in the two path passing the furlong grounds, and inched ahead. STICKY MCSHNICKENS got sent to vie for the lead inside, continued under a ride around the turn, fought on stubbornly down the stretch, but got edged out by the winner. NEONATE chased in the three path, was roused passing the quarter, swung from the five path into the lane, and ran on for show. FEAR raced up close in the four path, was roused from the three path midway around the turn, but finished evenly from the four path down the stretch. AEGON TARGARYEN was prompted from up close in the two path, driven from the rail around the turn, but faded in the stretch. ZEVI'S ZONE chased in the three path, was driven around the turn, fanned out to the five path at the top of the lane, but made no impact. JAMALAMADINGDONG duelled between foes in the three path, was driven in the two path around the turn, but gave way in the stretch.
