ONE SWEET GIRL unhurried early on, advanced from the outside four to five wide through the far turn and surged up late under strong handling. STRIKING FINALE settled off the early pace racing in hand, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to the wire. BERT'S KNOTY GIRL was allowed to settle early, moved up from the inside near the quarter pole and made a good late rally racing four wide. MORE APPLAUSE showed good early speed to set the pace and weakened a bit the final eighth of a mile. JUSTICE PREVAILS tracked the early leader wide, challenged for the lead into the lane and weakened late. ROGUE RUNNER stalked the top pair from the inside and weakened through the lane. STELLA BIONDA stalked the early pace three wide and faded.
