HOPE TOWN GIRL broke sharply, seized command after crossing over effectively, was clear into the stretch and pulled away under a drive. R TUN WHO raced forwardly along the inside, responded to pressure entering the stretch and finished well. MIMI WILLY stalked the pace, was asked to improve on the turn, went three wide for the stretch run and stayed on. TINKATWO bumped at the start, settled well, moved out six wide into the stretch and offered a late bid. DO I LOOK WORRIED chased while four wide, was swung five wide into the stretch and finished evenly. FIRE ON THE WIRE ducked in at the start bumping TINKATWO, got outpaced while five wide and was never involved. STARSHIP VENGEANCE was reserved four wide and lacked a rally. CATHOLIC VICE never menaced. FAR ABOVE was reluctant to load, trailed and was never involved. ALLURING SERENITY saved ground to no avail and faded.
