HE BE HOPPIN forwardly placed along the inside, advanced on the turn, responded to his cue, readily drew off in the stretch and was taken in hand late. R WINCHESTER worked his way to the front, was outpaced leaving the turn and stayed on in the stretch to hold off his stable mate for the place spot. BRUSHFIRE reserved out wide, advanced on the turn, went five wide into the stretch and stayed on. BEST MINET YET chased while five wide, moved closer on the turn and kept on in the stretch. SUPREME HONOR was off slowly and never menaced. NADIR HAN had brief speed and dropped back early. WINE CANDY saved ground, was steadied sharply on the turn and proved no factor thereafter.
