COOEY moved up inside the two early breakers to vie onto the main track, shook clear off the inside, continued to hold a daylight advantage through the turn while setting legitimate fractions and was not seriously menaced through the stretch while kept to pressure. PERMIAN BASIN broke near the rear, raced back off the pace while outside, began to advance midway on the turn remaining well wide, five path into the lane, rallied down the middle of the strip to gain the place, not a threat to the winner. MAJOR PRYCE hugged the rail when racing off the pace, continued to save ground through the turn when in a trifle bit tight briefly, cut the corner into the lane to reach closest to the winner with a furlong remaining, lacked a further advance and was caught late for the runner up spot. GIRVIN STAR broke well toward the inside, vied briefly early, chased the winner from the four path up the backstretch and into the turn, came with the runner up inside that one for the drive, not enough late for the second spot. PUCKERED last away, trailed well back off the inside, three wide turning for home, could still see them all past the furlong marker then found her best stride too late. DOMINANT DIVA broke well, vied early between horses, chased the winner into and through the turn off the inside, weakened in the drive. GALLOP D'HERMES was finished early, failed to muster a rally. MILITIA back off the pace, raced in the two path through the turn while between foes, gave way when the real running started turning for home.
