NICE TRY RILEY in the second flight early toward the inside, moved closer after a half, prompted the leader through early turn, engaged that one from the outside into the stretch and kicked clear under light handling to win ridden out. TEOFIMO in mid pack backstretch off the inside, moved into contention in the four path through the turn, too much to do to challenge the winner stretch, clearly second best. OPERA HOUSE A. D. asked away from the gate to clear, showed the way up the backstretch by daylight, continued to set the pace far turn, responded briefly when the winner challenged with a quarter remaining, began to give way when headed into the stretch, continued to steadily weaken to the wire to lose the second spot. NOBLE PRINCE void of early foot, began to advance inside early in the turn, tipped out to be three wide late in the bend, displayed some mild late interest to better his position a bit. EMERGING LEADER (ARG) away well from the outside, raced forwardly and four wide backstretch, headed up the second flight into the turn, gradually weakened to have little left the final furlong. JIMBO BAILEY devoid of any early foot, came four wide and between horses, improved position down the middle of the strip

without posing a serious threat. LAST SHALL B FIRST in mid pack early, steered out to be five wide turning into the lane, bettered himself by passing some faltering rivals, also was not a major player at the end. RASKOLNIKOV back off the pace and the inside, three wide and between horses midway on the turn, dropped inside, cut the corner into the lane but came up empty. LOOKING FOR STARS forwardly placed while three wide, gave way in the turn. UFO (PER) hesitated at the break, raced wide when trailing up the backstretch, fanned six wide into the lane, failed to muster a rally. WITCHA WISH finished early, fell far back, jogged in.
