JALAPENO took control soon after the start, showed the way onto the main track, narrowly led a busy first flight backstretch, continued to hold the advantage through the turn, shook off nearest rival when straightened for home and maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire while being kept to task. WOODSTER lacked early speed well out in the strip, race in the five path into turn, angled in slightly then was floated five wide when moving a bit closer turning for home, ground out the second spot while widest of the second flight, no threat to the winner. CLASSY PRINCE in the main group while in the five wide up the backstretch while between horses, raced four wide through the turn, challenged for the second slot while between horses with less than a furlong remaining, outkicked. CORISTINE behind the early leaders, moved closer up the inside then steadied when in tight with over five furlongs to run, recovered, advanced and lodged a mild bid in the two path outside the winner through the turn, could not keep pace into the lane and gradually weakened. FAR RIGHT off a step slow, raced back while just off the inside, split foes nearing midstretch to improve position a bit, not a serious threat. MR. KHOZAN forwardly placed while between horses off the inside, second flight in the two path turn, retreated in the run to the wire. PIKE within striking distance while four wide, continued well off the inside turn, four wide again exiting the turn, faltered in the drive to trail home.
