ARAUCANO tracked the early leader racing in hand near the rail, continued its inside run to challenge through the upper stretch and finished well to edge clear under strong handling. NOAHS PRIDE set his own uncontested early pace, shifted off the inside midway through the far turn into the lane to raced four wide and kept on gamely to the wire. TYBEE ECHO dropped back early, raced three to four wide around the far turn and moved up to improve position. SOFOCLES urged two wide between rivals and weakened a bit through the drive. MAJESTIC NOIR chased the pace outside of rivals and weakened through the lane. SWEET INTERLUDE raced near the back early, angled in to save ground and never threatened. LODATO off very slow, lost a considerable amount of ground at the break and trailed.
