SEVERELY OVERPAYIN prominent early on while between runners, pressed the solid pace into the turn, dueled AMERICAN REIGN to upper stretch then drew to even terms nearing the furlong grounds, took command approaching the final sixteenth and drew away under firm urging in deep stretch. AMERICAN REIGN broke out and crowded an outer rival at the start but was away in good order, showed speed and set the pace from the inside heading to the turn, was pressured to the quarter marker by SEVERELY OVERPAYIN then met that foe's bid into upper stretch, was no match late for the winner and held for the place. GODDESS OF BEAUTY was close up to the early pace while three wide, stalked the solid pace into the turn then lost ground into upper stretch, was outkicked in the lane, fought on late and just missed for the place, while clear of the rest for the show. KISSED BY A ROSE hopped then squeezed back at the start, settled while saving ground, kept an inside path to the quarter marker, ran on to mid-stretch but could not muster a late rally. SLEW LADY lunged then stumbled at the start and was last away from the gate, settled two wide to the turn, lacked the needed response at the quarter pole then failed to threaten in the drive. TOMORROW'S AGENDA off slow and crowded a bit by an inner rival at the break, settled outside, trailed into the turn, was outrun to the quarter pole, eased through the stretch and walked off.
