GIVE ME OPTIONS settled outside, tracked two to three wide to the half-mile, bid three wide to upper stretch, edged away in the final sixteenth and proved best. FLAMEFIRE settled to the backstretch, gained ground four wide to the quarter marker, swung five wide to upper stretch, chased the winner late and held for second. KISSINTHELADIES vied for the early lead then ceded to ROCKY LAGOON, tracked the pace while off of the rail heading into the far turn, got caught in traffic into upper stretch, needed more to the final sixteenth and just missed for second, while holding safely for third. AMBERSSOHN settled in the second flight early on then was caught a bit in tight between foes into the first turn, saved ground along the backstretch run, encountered traffic nearing the quarter marker, found a seam to upper stretch then gained at the furlong marker, caught a bit in tight while along the fence into the final sixteenth and lacked a late response. NUMINOUS vied for the early lead, took back and tracked the pace two to three wide along the backstretch, gave chase two to three wide to the quarter pole, gave way stretch. ROCKY LAGOON raced in the second flight leaving the gate, made an early move between foes into the first turn and took command, set the pace to the quarter marker, overtaken to upper stretch and faded in the drive.

LIA'S LOVE hopped at the start and off a step slowly, tracked the early pace from the second flight then loomed two wide and between foes into the turn, took command passing the quarter marker then drifted out to upper stretch, drew off through the lane and was ridden out to win as much the best. SHEILA MAGIC off slow leaving the start, shifted to the outside of rivals along the backstretch, loomed three wide nearing the quarter marker, got floated out a bit by LIA'S LOVE to upper stretch, was no match for the winner into the lane but was a clear second best. ONE MORE ROUND close up to the early pace, chased from the inside along the turn, encountered traffic nearing the quarter pole, swung out to upper stretch, was not able to impact the top pair in the lane but kept on to be a clear third. SATIRA bobbled start, sent to contest the early pace, led from the inside nearing the quarter pole, overtaken to upper stretch, faded in the drive. TOMORROW'S AGENDA broke alertly, vied early, stopped turn, lost action and fell then was euthanized on the track.

LADY CHANCE sent to vie for the early lead, took command then set pace from the inside into the turn, met bid of THE BEASTER BUNNY to upper stretch, dug in gamely to the final sixteenth, held well for the win. THE BEASTER BUNNY broke alertly, ceded the early lead then stalked to the turn, bid from the two to three path to upper stretch, was kept at bay by the determined winner into the final sixteenth but held well late for the place. MY GIRL NINA off step slow at the start, advanced in the early stages then was close up to the pace while saving ground, raced a bit in tight nearing the quarter marker, angled four wide to upper stretch, lacked a final response in deep stretch but was a good third. ZANY LADY lost her footing at the start and broke a step slowly, settled outside in the early stages, made a steady gain three wide into the turn, ran in pursuit five wide to upper stretch, lost ground into the lane and flattened out in the final stages. ALLURING SERENITY bobbled and squeezed at the start and last away from the gate, gained from the inside along the turn, angled out to upper stretch, could not sustain a run to the final sixteenth and also flattened out. CHERI CHERI LADY settled in the second flight to begin, ran in pursuit two wide and between foes into the turn, angled to the rail upper stretch, weakened in the drive. BOOMBOX BETTY allowed to settle early on, coaxed three wide to the quarter pole, angled in nearing mid-stretch, failed to threaten late.

DEL MAR SUNRISE (IRE) settled outside early, was blocked then steadied behind runners at the quarter marker, continued to race in traffic to upper stretch, angled out and bid into the final furlong, couldn't keep pace with the winner into the final sixteenth and just missed for the place.
