HANDS OF TIME assumed early command, set a decent pace while well handled to the half-mile marker, met the bid of ACT A FOOL at the quarter marker, turned away that one at mid-stretch then dug in, was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in deep stretch but lasted for the win. RASHID well placed while saving ground, tipped three wide to upper stretch, closed determinedly into the final sixteenth and just missed for the win, while well clear of the rest for the place. ACT A FOOL forwardly placed, tracked the decent pace to the half-mile marker, bid two wide at the quarter pole then battled HANDS OF TIME to upper stretch, repelled at the furlong grounds but kept on and held well late for the show. BROTHER BRAD settled along the inside, kept a ground saving path to the far turn then rallied along the rail to upper stretch, was gaining in the final sixteenth and just missed for the show honors. TITAN settled mid-pack while saving ground, shifted to the two path into the far turn, navigated traffic between rivals to upper stretch then finished evenly in the lane. EDDIE THE GREAT settled mid-pack, coaxed two wide and between foes heading to the half-mile marker, asked three wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and finished evenly. KALIK forwardly placed away from the gate then settled in the second flight, well placed while three wide

approaching the second turn, chased three then four wide nearing the top of the lane, lacked a late rally. BAKERS STREET lost his path at the start and was off slowly, settled between rivals, moved out to the three path along the backstretch, swung five wide for the stretch drive and failed to threaten late. ZOZAN settled three wide to the first turn, coaxed four wide to the half-mile marker, trailed into the far turn and did not factor in the stretch drive.

DIMANCHE GRAS prominent early, attended to the modest fractions into the backstretch, went up to vie for the lead into the far turn, battled WILLING ONE into the lane then shook free of that rival at mid-stretch, drew clear to the final sixteenth and kept to task under hand urging late. OUTTA MONEY well placed while saving ground, chased the leading pair to the quarter marker then angled out to upper stretch, couldn't match strides with the winner into the final sixteenth but stayed on well late and was a clear second. REFINED HONOR settled to the first turn, coaxed three wide along the backstretch, ran in pursuit three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, made a mild rally into the stretch and got up in time to earn the show honors. WILLING ONE took early command, set modest fractions while prompted to the far turn, met the bid of DIMANCHE GRAS to upper stretch, couldn't find more into the final furlong and gave way. CANDY ADDICTION jostled at the start and trailed to the first turn, settled between rivals into the backstretch, caught a bit in tight nearing the far turn, shifted to the rail and chased from the inside approaching the quarter marker, lacked the needed response in the drive and weakened late. SANTAL reared up and unseated the rider leaving the start, ran loose during the race, was caught following the race and walked off. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' REVIEW INTO THE START FOR SANTAL, THE STEWARDS DETERMINED THAT RUNNER CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS AT THE START AND NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE.

QUEEN KWAINA settled while saving ground, made a steady gain from the inside heading into the turn, kept a rail path to the quarter marker then angled out to upper stretch, loomed three to four wide at the furlong pole, took command to the final sixteenth, dug in late and held over the oncoming runner-up. MISS VALENTINA settled mid-pack, got shuffled back a bit into the turn, coaxed along while widest nearing the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch then rallied from the six to seven path to deep stretch, closed fast in the final sixteenth and missed for the win, while getting up for the place. LA CYBER off a bit awkwardly and a step slow leaving the gate, was hustled to contest the early pace from outside of SOMERSET MIA, disputed the pace into the turn and battled into upper stretch, shook free into the final furlong, was overtaken at the sixteenth pole, stubbornly fought on to deep stretch and was outfinished for the win and place in the final yards, while holding safely for the show. PRETTY GEISHA settled mid-pack, chased between rivals into the turn, angled to the inside into upper stretch, mounted a mild late rally but needed more in the final sixteenth. MISCHIEF MOTION bobbled at the start and last away from the gate, settled then was steered widest along the backstretch, gained ground three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, spun to the five to six path to upper stretch then was caught in tight between foes into the lane, made a mild late rally but needed more in the final stages. CALLING THE SHOTS was forwardly placed to begin, tracked the leading pair into the turn, chased from the three path nearing the top of the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging into upper stretch, churned on to the final sixteenth but couldn't find the needed late response. SOMERSET MIA prominent away from the gate, contested the early pace from the inside, disputed a decent pace into the turn, vied into upper stretch, began to lose ground past mid-stretch and faded late.

INOLENTA away in good order and took early command, set a decent pace while well handled to the half-mile marker, kicked clear into the far turn then widened the lead to the stretch, kept to task to the final sixteenth and held over the oncoming runner-up. PLAGNE CHAMPAGNE crowded a bit between rivals away from the start, advanced along the inside heading into the first turn and stalked the pace into the backstretch, lost ground to INSOLENTA into the far turn then chased the pacesetter to upper stretch, fought on to the final sixteenth, was gaining late but couldn't reel in the winner in deep stretch and was a clear second. STARSHIP ELATION allowed to settle early, gained ground three to four wide at the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch, was no match for the top pair into the stretch drive but stayed on well late and was a clear third. LOGISTICS forwardly placed early on, was caught in tight between rivals approaching the first turn then forced out ANNIE GOODBODY into that bend, settled while saving ground to the backstretch, chased from the inside to the quarter marker, swung to the two path to upper stretch, couldn't sustain a bid to the final sixteenth and flattened out. PUCKERED unhurried
