FANTASY PERFORMER reserved in last, commenced her bid far on the turn, circled the field while five wide into the stretch and was up in the last forty yards under a drive. LITTLE JAMIE settled well four wide, advanced on the far turn, continued with a four wide bid, led late but was caught. MISS MARY NELL broke sharply, raced forwardly, gained ground on the far turn and finished well in the stretch. HELLO HELLO HELLO outpaced early, moved closer on the far turn, lacked room behind rivals in the stretch run and stayed on. TURINO settled well, was in contention on the far turn, angled in for the stretch run and managed a mild bid. LETS GO KOKO chased the pacesetter and lacked a substantive rally. DO GOODER assumed at the command seven-eighths marker, led a close-knit group into the stretch and gave way late.
