SECRET EMPIRE sent, dueled pace inside, battled stretch, shook free late, proved best. LUCKY OLD SON pressed outside, dueled stretch, game, bested, clear second. NESHUME settled inside, saved ground to stretch, rallied and was a clear third. BACK EM UP took back, tracked between two wide to the quarter pole, passed tired foes in the final furlong. MR. PEEKS had a shoe repaired prior to the race, tracked the early pace inside, shifted out and chased to mid-stretch, weakened in the late stages. TSHIEBWE tracked between three wide to turn, chased to mid-stretch, no late rally. ADVERSARY tracked four wide to turn, no late response.
