LA CYBER hustled up the fence to the lead in the early going, set a well measured pace under mild pressure to midway on the turn, repelled the bid of the runner-up turning for home to kick away down the lane. SOMERSET MIA stalked the pace from four wide into the turn, edged up to narrow the margin steadily on the bend, cruised up to the leader at the quarter pole to engage for the stretch run, failed to pass in upper stretch and ran-on as second best. NIPSEY reserved off the pace to race near the rear of the field, commenced a steady rally midway on the turn and finished with good interest to be along for the show. PRETTY GEISHA rated in mid-pack to the turn, lost position idling on the bend and rallied to be best of the rest. GHOSTLIGHT prominently placed along the rail while well held down the backstretch, tracked through the turn and failed to mount a closing bid. CALLING THE SHOTS pressed the pace from five wide down the backstretch, was put to an early drive on the turn, failed to respond and steadily faded toward the rear. MISCHIEF MOTION was not a factor.
