HIGH GREATNESS stalked between foes, ranged up confidently to bid passing the three-eighths pole, held command while being cued from the two path just after the quarter, drew away in upper stretch, and held safe. FAR RIGHT was hustled along from in range between rivals early, driven in the three path around the turn, drifted out down the lane, but ran on to clearly be second best. REPROCHE raced up close in the two path, lost a few spots while waiting behind a rival around the turn, then finished on one pace along the rail down the lane. CADENCED showed the way along the inside, came under a drive when challenged by an outer rival passing the three-eighths pole, lost the lead before the quarter, tipped out to the three path at the top of the lane, then faded. WORDSOFINSPIRATION broke out at the start, rated along the rail, came under a ride midway around the turn, but weakened in the stretch. ATOMIC DON was off slow, angled outside of rivals and chased from there early, ranged up in the four path midway around the turn, but came up empty entering the stretch. MR. AVENTUS trailed throughout and was eased through the final furlong.
