WORLD TRAVELER prompted the pace the entire way from three wide, rallied in upper stretch to edge ever closer to the pacesetter and wore that one down in the final eighth to be going clear late. TERRIE T set the pace at a slow tempo to be well rationed on a measured lead, responded when engaged in upper stretch battling through the lane and gave way grudgingly late to be second best. DAS IST ALLES ALLY rated in mid-pack to be within striking distance at the quarter pole and rallied mildly to be along for the show. POCKET PAIR slow early to be the trailer, remained unhurried at the back to midway on the final turn and showed some late interest passing weaker in the lane. TIC TIC TIC BOOM stalked the leaders for three-quarter and lacked a closing response going evenly. COMPASS RISES went evenly posing no threat.
