BRAVENESS set the pace under steady pressure to the quarter pole, shook clear in upper stretch and was unthreatened in the lane. WHEELHOUSE stalked the dueling pacesetters from the fence to be well placed, rallied up the rail turning for home, failed to close the gap on the winner and finished willingly as second best. ACTIVITY pressed the pace from three wide to the top of the stretch, was no match for the leader in the lane and kept-on while weakening to be best of the rest. EMINENT POWER reserved off the pace in mid-pack and rallied mildly coming home without impact. CASE LAW broke well but retreated to the rear in the first few strides, trailed to midway on the turn and showed some late interest. SHADIDELBAS tracked the leaders to mid-stretch and faded in the final furlong. NUMINOUS failed to menace proving no threeat at any point. FLYING ASH was a non-factor having been outrun.
