MEGAPLUMB broke slow to give the field several lengths, angled in rushing to contention into the first turn, was hard held to be kept off heels while racing between rivals through the turn, remained between in traffic to the far turn, angled out five wide at the top of the lane and rallied well when in the clear to be up in the final sixteenth while showing signs of greeness in the lane. BANDARI set the pace on a well measured lead for three-quarters, responded when called upon turning for home to maintain the advantage to deep stretch and was overtaken late in a good effort. TULIO stalked the pace from four wide in the clear to midway on the final turn, rallied to loom at the top of the lane and failedto get passed the pacesetter through the lane. SAVE OUR SOUL tracked the leaders from the fence to be well placed in a prominent position when cutting the corner turning for home and flattened out in the final furlong. EH HAN chased the leaders from four wide in the second flight to midway on the far turn and faded. POWER ROYAL pressed the pace from between rivals to early on the final bend and gave way lacking a response when called on in the turn. BRO broke slow to give the field a few lengths and never recovered trailing throughout.
