ARABIA WILD pressed the pace down the backside, rallied three wide to take a short lead at the quarter pole, repelled the sustained bids of the pacesetter and the rallying show horse in mid-stretch and pulled clear late in a well handled ride. COMMENDATORE set teh pace under pressure to midway on the turn, surrendered the lead turning for home, came back stubbornly to battle in upper stretch and ran on while unable to match the winner late. NICE TRY RILEY rated in the early going to race mid-pack, rallied to prominence on the turn, took a short lead five wide in upper stretch when sweeping to engage the leaders and was turned away in mid-stretch. RULE SEVENTY SIX trailed to the top of the lane and showed some late interest passing weaker in the stretch. EL OREJON failed to menace. HARD TALK raced up from the back of the pace to close the gap on the turn and failed to sustain the bid fading from contention down the lane. CLASSIC EQUATION pressed the early pace and was through after a half mile.
