MISS T BOBO was prominent in the early running, stalked the pace two to three wide into the turn, advanced at the quarter marker then confronted CURLY SUE into upper stretch, vied for the lead nearing the furlong grounds, took command into the final sixteenth and drew clear in deep stretch. CURLY SUE sent to assume early command, set the pace to the quarter marker then showed the way to upper stretch, met the bid of MISS T BOBO at the furlong grounds, could not match strides with the winner late and held safely for second. SOVEREIGN GOLD rated off of the early pace, advanced three wide into the turn then chased to mid-stretch, could not find a final response and was well clear for third. TRILL raced in tight soon after the start and checked approaching to the five-eighths marker, recovered and chased the pace to the turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch, passed tiring rivals in the drive but could not threaten the leaders in the late stages. RIYAH AL NIL was forwardly placed in the early stages, chased the pace from the inside heading to the turn, could not keep pace nearing the quarter marker and tired in the stretch drive. CAMM'S GIRL was crowded at the start and a step slow leaving the gate, chased the pace three to four wide heading to the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker, gave way in the stretch, was eased in the late stages and walked off.
