BOLD ADVANCE tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, chased four wide into the turn then vied for the lead at the quarter marker, battled three wide to mid-stretch, weakened in the late stages and just missed for third. PET MAT settled off of the moderate early pace, swung five wide for the stretch drive and did not offer a late response. KIKILOVE went up to assume command leaving the chute, set a moderate pace while clear into the turn, was overtaken at the quarter marker, could not keep pace with the leaders to upper stretch and faded in the drive. REMERTON raced close up to the early pace while between runners, gave chase two wide into the turn, was caught in tight midway through the bend then checked at the five-sixteenths marker, lost position at the quarter pole then and tired in the stretch. HONESTO settled off of the moderate early pace, coaxed three to four wide into the turn, could not keep pace to the quarter marker and did not threaten in the stretch drive.
