DITCHED settled while saving ground into the first turn, unhurried while not far back nearing the half-mile point, angled three then four wide along the far turn and loomed to upper stretch, rallied and drew to even terms with SEEKING A PRAYER into the final sixteenth, surged in deep stretch and held off his stablemate in the final strides to prevail. MOOR STRENGTH bobbled leaving the start and was off a step slowly, was unhurried early on then trailed into the turn, advanced three wide nearing the quarter marker, shifted four wide at mid-stretch and closed well into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch and got up in time for second. CAJUN ANTHEM broke alertly and showed good speed away from the start, disputed the pace into the turn then took command along the bend, drifted out a bit to upper stretch and was set down at the furlong marker, was all out past mid-stretch, yielded to the top pair in the final sixteenth and was clear in the end for third. BIG BOB allowed to settle in the early going, was roused three then four wide approaching the far turn, loomed at the quarter marker and vied for the lead to upper stretch, battled EXCUSES to the furlong grounds, repelled that foe into the final sixteenth then drew clear in deep stretch. SEAWISE was prominent away from the start, ceded the early lead and stalked from the inside into the first turn, was well placed while saving ground to the half-mile pole, chased from the rail nearing the quarter marker, angled three then four wide for the stretch drive, closed into the final sixteenth and got up in time for the place honors. FLAG OFFICER settled in mid-pack and three wide early on, advanced between rivals into the second turn, rallied three wide to upper stretch then dove to the rail into the final sixteenth, was gaining late and just missed for second on the wire. EXCUSES was forwardly placed to the first turn, stalked the decent pace along the backstretch, vied for the lead two wide and between rivals nearing the quarter pole, battled into the stretch, was turned away by BIG BOB into the final sixteenth, yielded late and was outfinished for the minor awards. SKI BUM settled off of the early pace while never far back, was coaxed two then three wide into the far turn, swung four wide to upper stretch and was put in tight at the three-sixteenths marker, recovered into the final furlong, made a mild rally to deep stretch but needed more late.
