ONLY YOU settled outside of rivals while never far back early on, roused three wide nearing the quarter marker then mounted a four wide rally into upper stretch, vied for the lead at the furlong grounds and battled ADSILA to the final sixteenth, turned away the runner-up in deep stretch then edged away late to prove best. ADSILA close up to the early pace, stalked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, roused two wide to the stretch and vied for the lead at the furlong marker, met the bid of ONLY YOU into the final sixteenth, was outfinished by the winner and held for second at the wire. CALL THE BULLPEN broke alertly and took early command, set a moderate pace to the half-mile point, showed the way to the quarter pole, dug in to upper stretch, yielded to the top pair late and was clear in the end for third. MIAMI STYLE settled just off of the early pace, well placed while saving ground along the backstretch, maintained an inside trip to the quarter marker, chased to the furlong grounds and was outkicked in the final sixteenth. LUCKY BERRY settled mid-pack while saving ground, tipped two wide at the quarter marker, chased to the final sixteenth, no final bid. WELL SHAKEN allowed to settle, unhurried to the half-mile marker, saved ground into the far turn, advanced along the rail to mid-stretch, could not sustain a late run and flattened out. ESTRELLA off a step slowly, advanced into the backstretch, chased three wide to the quarter marker, no late bid. AFFIRMING caught in traffic while a bit keen into the first turn, settled into the backstretch, angled three then four wide for the stretch drive, no late rally. SHE GRINS allowed to settle, coaxed three wide along the backstretch, chased to the quarter marker, fanned five to six wide to upper stretch, no threat late.

HOLLYWOOD MAYHEM drifted in a bit soon after the start, showed good early speed and disputed the pace from the inside heading into the turn, dueled MIGHTY MURPHY to the quarter marker, dug in into upper stretch and led to the furlong pole, responded into the final sixteenth and kicked clear in the late stages. WILD WEST JUSTICE veered in soon after the start, put a pair of inner rivals in tight early on then rated off of the contested early pace, tracked from the inside then angled three wide nearing the quarter marker, bid three deep into upper stretch, was outkicked by the winner into the final sixteenth and bested the rest. PRINCE DAVID was crowded early on by an outer rival then put DON'T ANSWER in tight soon after the break, recovered and settled off of the contested early pace, roused four wide to the stretch, closed into the final sixteenth and got up in time to earn the show. MIGHTY MURPHY disputed the early pace outside of HOLLYWOOD MAYHEM, dueled to the quarter pole, vied between rivals to upper stretch and battled into the final furlong, faded in the final sixteenth and was outfinished late for the show honors. BOUNDFORTROUBLE bobbled at the start and was a step slow to begin, tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, chased three wide to the quarter marker, weakened in the lane. SNEAK PREVIEW rated just off of the early pace, tracked between rivals into the turn, chased from the inside to upper stretch, gave way. DON'T ANSWER crowded then took up while in tight soon after the break, recovered and trailed into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch, no late rally. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START OF THIS RACE. THE STEWARDS RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.

INSOLENTA prominent away from the start and ceded the early lead, stalked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker then took command into the far turn, drew off nearing the quarter pole, romped through the stretch and was hand urged to the wire to win as much the best. AWESOME CAMPAIGN allowed to settle early, advanced four wide nearing the quarter marker, was no match for the winner into the drive, ran on into the final sixteenth and got up in time to earn the place honors. MUSCLE MAIDEN settled in the second flight and three wide early on, tracked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, ran in pursuit of INSOLENTA into the far turn, was no match for the winner into the stretch, was caught late for the place honors and was well clear of the rest for the show. STARLIGHT LUNA settled and saved ground to the first turn, unhurried along the backstretch, got caught in traffic into the far turn, swung four to five wide to upper stretch and passed tiring rivals late. NIPSEY hopped at the start and off a bit slowly, was unhurried to the backstretch and trailed to the far turn, passed tiring rivals to upper stretch and ran on into the final furlong while not able to threaten the leaders late. LUCKY FLAY forwardly place to the first turn, settled while saving ground into the backstretch, chased two wide to the quarter pole, lacked a response to upper stretch and tired in the drive. GOULDIAN allowed to settle, coaxed along outside of rivals into the far turn, swung five to six wide to upper stretch and did not factor late. TIZ FOR MATT

PHOENIX OF WIT (IRE) vied for the early lead then took command into the first turn, disputed a solid pace between rivals heading to the half-mile pole, chased MISCHIEF IN MOTION into the far turn, could not keep pace into upper stretch and tired in the drive. FEDE settled just off of the contested early pace, was carried wide into the first turn then settled outside of rivals into the backstretch, well placed while four deep heading to the half-mile marker, gave chase into the far turn, could not match strides leaving the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. THE JOCKEY ON RAMSEY POND LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF CRAFTY COLLECTOR, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE IN THE RUN TO THE FIRST TURN. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THAT OBJECTION AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.
