CLASSIC OF COURSE allowed to settle early while never far back, tracked outside of rivals approaching the turn, advanced two wide at the quarter marker, chased into upper stretch then angled four wide at the furlong marker, closed determinedly into the final sixteenth and wore down rivals in deep stretch to prevail. STEPPE was forwardly placed away from the start, stalked the moderate pace up the backstretch, confronted ROAR OF THE BEAST into the turn, battled that rival to upper stretch then dueled into the final furlong, vied between rivals into the final sixteenth, was outfinished in deep stretch and held well late for the place. ROAR OF THE BEAST assumed early command, set a moderate pace up the backstretch then showed the way into the turn, met the bid of STEPPE nearing the quarter marker and battled that rival to upper stretch, gamely dueled inside of STEPPE into the final furlong, was bested for the win and place in deep stretch and held safely at the wire for the show honors. NOTHINGSUBTLE tracked the early pace from the inside and was well placed to the turn, shifted to the two path nearing the quarter marker then chased to upper stretch, ran in pursuit to the furlong pole, angled out to the final sixteenth and could not find the needed late response. KEEP ON MOVING settled off of the early pace while never far back, chased between rivals into the turn, got shuffled back midway through the bend, could not find more into the stretch and gave way in the final furlong.
