BOTH SIDES was prominent away from the start, angled off of the rail and stalked the early pace two wide heading to the turn, went up to vie for the lead midway through the bend, took command nearing the quarter marker then drew clear into the stretch, kept to task under moderate urging in the drive and held sway to the wire. IT'S ONLY WORDS settled just off of the early pace while outside of rivals, advanced three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, chased BOTH SIDES into upper stretch, could not reel in the winner into the final sixteenth and held well late for second. SMART JENNY rated off of the early pace, saved ground along the backstretch then advanced into the turn, was well placed nearing the quarter pole, shifted two wide to upper stretch and ran in pursuit to the furlong pole, re-rallied into the final sixteenth and missed for the place, while well clear of the rest for the show. NEOM CITY settled off of the early pace while not far back, coaxed two to three wide along the turn, spun four wide for the stretch drive and did not rally late. TIMELY REWARD hustled for the early lead, assumed command and set the pace to the turn, met the bid of BOTH SIDES then was overtaken nearing the quarter marker, chased that rival to upper stretch, could not find more into the final furlong and faded. OLGA off a step slowly leaving the start, lacked early speed and trailed to the half-mile pole, coaxed from the three path nearing the quarter marker and did not factor in the stretch drive.
