FULL DISCLOSURE sent leaving the start, assumed early command and set a pressured pace along the backstretch, dueled inside of AND UWISH into the turn, battled that rival into upper stretch, turned away AND UWISH past the furlong pole and kept to task late to prove best. AND UWISH raced close up to the early pace, went up and pressed the pace outside of FULL DISCLOSURE heading into the turn, disputed the solid pace to the quarter marker then battled FULL DISCLOSURE into upper stretch, was turned away into the final furlong, chased the winner to the final sixteenth and held for second at the finish. ASHER'S EDGE tracked the solid early pace from the inside, saved ground into the turn and was well placed nearing the quarter marker, angled three wide to upper stretch, could not muster the needed late response but got up in time to earn the show honors. KNOCKANARA settled off of the solid early pace, saved ground into the turn then rallied into upper stretch, chased within aim into the final furlong was outkicked in deep stretch and just missed for the show honors. SOSUA SUMMER settled off of the early pace, roused four wide into the turn, chased five wide to upper stretch and did not rally late. BIG PARADISE unseated the rider and ran loose prior to the race, was away in good order and rated just off of the early pace, tracked between rivals into the turn then chased three wide to the quarter pole, spun four wide to upper stretch, could not find the needed response at the furlong marker and weakened. NESHUME raced close up to the early pace while outside of rivals, stalked three deep into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker, gave way into upper stretch and did not offer a final response.
