## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

NEW LIFE vied for the early lead on the inside, then drew clear on the far turn and was still clear off the bend and then went to a walk nearing the furlong marker and passed but was resurgent in the final sixteenth to come back and prove best under a drive. WORLD BUILDER was allowed to settle three wide and advanced three wide by the quarter pole and came four wide into the lane to make a bid and gained a short lead nearing the sixteenth marker but hung late and relented the lead. LITTLE GUSSIE was allowed to settle along the inside and angled out in the lane and had a late rally to gain the show award. MIAMI STYLE was well rated early three to two wide, made advanced two wide by the quarter pole and came three wide off the turn to make a bid but flattened out in the final furlong. RAINBOW LANE was reserved on the outside and was three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the lane and had a belated rally. MYSTERY DATE was reserved early towards the inside but lacked a rally. WICKEDTHISWAYCOMES vied for the lead three wide and then pressed the winner two wide but tired. FACE OF SHADOWS was settled back early, moved out to have outside pursuit and then stopped. RIYAH AL NIL steadied on the inside into the first turn and then was thru after a half mile.
