## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

FREDDIE B was well placed along the inside tracking the leaders, came under coaxing midway on the turn then made a inside bid leaving the turn and was put to a long drive and dueled for command by the sixteenth marker and then edged clear late to prove best under crop urging. DIAMOND KNIFE vied for the leas on the inside and then came under coaxing by the five sixteenths and came two wide off the bend, duG in gamely in the drive and was in between rivals by the furlong marker and fought on to the wire but was out-gamed late. THE PULSE stalked the early pace from the outside and then went up to prompt the pace nearing the half mile marker and then vied for command midway on the turn and made was four wide by the quarter pole and came five wide off the bend while vying for command drifted out slightly in the furlong grounds under left handed crop urging but was out-kicked by the top two. ONE REWARD tracked the leaders two to three wide, made a five wide bid nearing the quarter pole and came six wide off the bend, was forced out in the furlong grounds and tad while flattening out. VINO VICI vied for the early lead three to two wide, between rivals on the turn and fought on to the furlong marker but weakened. The rider on the number two ONE REWARD filed an OBJECTION against the number seven THE PULSE for interference in the stretch, after the STEWARDS reviewed the replays the OBJECTION was DISALLOWED.
