TIMELESS VICTORY chased the early pace and was two to three wide on the turn while getting closer to the leader, came four wide into the lane and idled to the furlong marker and then rallied well late to get up between rivals under a drive. CABOURG was away alertly despite having a bobble to set an unchallenged pace on the inside while well clear, then moved out to the two path nearing the quarter pole while still clear, then was put to a drive leaving the three sixteenths but was caught late to just fail. MY BOY STAN chased the pace on the outside and advanced three to four wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane, rallied well on the outside to loom boldly by the sixteenth marker but hung late. MOVE JESSE MOVE hit the gate at the start and settled along the inside, saved ground on the turn and advanced midway on the turn, cut the corner leaving the turn and was slowly gaining the angled out nearing the sixteenth marker and then back in late but needed more. SIR NEWTONS LAWS chased the pace from between rivals and then fell back on the turn and was two wide by the quarter pole but had no rally.
