## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

NOBLE J was away in good order and dueled for the early lead outside a rival, made a two wide bid to draw clear entering the turn while under a good hold, then came two wide off the bend while clear switched leads leaving the three sixteenths and drew out to prove best under mild pressure. NOBLE SKY stalked the pace three wide and made a mild bid three wide on the turn but proved to be no match for the winner while keeping on to be second best. PLAYA AZUL tracked the early pace along the inside and then moved out to be coaxed along two wide on the turn and swung out four wide leaving the bend and ran on late to clearly best the rest. KRAKEN had an awkward start and was off a couple of lengths slow, chased the pace on the outside and was four wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane but lacked a rally. LOMAX was outrun early despite being under urging, raced on the inside to the two path on the turn and never factored. ONE MORE DUKE dueled for the lead on the inside and then weakened on the turn and was empty in the drive.
