TIME TICKER was unhurried for a half mile then closed fast when asked for speed, rallied three then four wide to take over into the stretch and held driving. NO ORDINARY TIGER was settled for a half mile then also closed quickly on the leaders to the quarter pole, took the lead on the far turn but could not stall then winner while besting the rest. RIDING BY was outrun for a half mile, rallied three wide but was no match for the top two. GOLDEN RIVER had good speed, dueled inside for five furlongs then was overtaken and weakened. PISTOL POWER was a pace factor between horses for a half mile, was passed nearing the quarter pole and gave way. HOUSE OF LORDS had no speed and was never a threat. CORN POP was a pace factor for a half mile and tired. GREAT RUNNER was hustled while outside rivals to dispute the pace while widest but gave out and five furlongs.
