MISCHIEFS CAUSEWAY broke alertly but was drifting inward leaving the chute under right handed urging and crossed in front of MR. EXECUTIVE and UNCLE LEON, causing both to take up, prompted the pace, rallied three wide and took the lead on the second turn then dug in late to prevail. UNCLE LEON took up leaving the chute when the winner crossed over, dueled inside two others to the quarter pole, got outkicked by the winner to the stretch then saved the place desperately. NAVAL HARBOR was mid pack early, commenced a bid off the rail into the second turn and closed willingly to just miss second. MISSED CALL had no speed, was two wide leaving the quarter pole, shifted three wide to the stretch and finished willingly. NATION OF FAITH was also outrun early, made a bid leaving the quarter pole but had to swing five deep to the stretch and finished with interest. MATTAWA N THAT was four wide early, chased the pace, remained four wide to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. MR. EXECUTIVE took up early when MISCHIEFS CAUSEWAY crossed over in front of him, tracked the pace for four furlongs then tried to rally three wide but was giving way late. A VIEW FROM ABOVE chased the pace while saving ground on both turns but tired in the final furlong. WORKDAY had no speed and was not a factot. DAD'S JUBILEE was used early to set the pace, briefly dueled when collared but then tired after four furlongs and stopped. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the race and disqualified MISCHIEFS CAUSEWAY from first to second for interference to UNCLE LEON leaving the chute.
