SHERRYS BABY chased the leader, was kept to task on the backstretch, rallied inside to the stretch then finished steadily to grab the lead late. CHATTY LEROYBROWN had the best speed, widened on the backstretch, responded to the furlong marker then was tiring but determinedly saved second. BOB'S VAI chased the leader to the second turn, was two then three wide to the stretch and was gaining late. SHANGHAI BARBIE had no speed, saved ground to the stretch and closed a gap. MONARCA DE ORO also was outrun for three furlongs, saved ground to the stretch and had a mild late gain. BAKBURNER chased the pace to the quarter pole, got fanned four wide to the stretch and could not make an impact late. SAVITA had no speed and was not a threat. BOURBON TIGER broke out then was straightened and used early, chased two wide for a half mile then weakened.
