HER BLIND SIDE ducked in a bit at the start then was unhurried to the backstretch, rallied three wide to the stretch, got to terms with BOURBON BAYOU a sixteenth out then led and held on. BETHEL RIDGE chased the pace for three furlongs, rallied two then three wide to the stretch then closed fast to grab the place. BOURBON TIGER set the pace for a half mile, met the winner's bid to mid stretch then was outkicked and tagged late for second. BLOWING BAYOU pressed the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch but lacked then needed late response. MIDNIGHT SYMPHONY was bumped at the start, had no speed and was never a threat. CALY BALI broke out and bumped MIDNIGHT SYMPHONY, recovered then bore out to about the six path on the first turn then trailed and gave way.
