CLUBHOUSE DRAMA stalked the pace to the backstretch then eased out, rallied three deep to take the lead into the second turn, responded and held driving. PRINCESS PAYTON hustled to show speed and dueled to the backstretch, got outkicked by the winner and was four wide to the stretch then finished willingly to get second. SHANGHAI BARBIE also was used to show speed, dueled two wide to the second turn then got outkicked and lacked the needed late response. LUTE'S DIAMOND stalked the leaders early, saved ground to the stretch then finished evenly. HAUGHTY KITTY had no speed, was three wide throughout and did not threaten. MO SUGAFOOT attended the pace from the rail to the eighth pole then got outkicked and weakened. LUCY L had no speed and was not a factor. JAZZY LOVE was in tight behind horses, checked the took up, lugged out on the first turn then raced very wide throughout.
