COUNT THE GREEN responded when shoved on in the opening yards and sprinted away into the turn, drifted out briefly before being corrected near the three eighths, dictated the pace two wide around the turn, widened under some hand encouragement in mid stretch, was given a sharp left handed ask a sixteenth out then remained comfortably in front while mildly hand ridden late. CIAO TOMMASO , away alertly, pursued to the inside of a rival around the turn and into the stretch, altered out for the final furlong and kept on willingly to nab the place through the final yards. GOOD YEGG gave pursuit three wide outside CIAO TOMMASO, circled into the stretch, chased on past mid stretch but was out finished for second. LORD BLOCK was tossing his head about just before the gates sprung, broke a tad slow and inward, was forced out badly by LESLEY'S LEGACY soon after, dropped well off the pace, came wide for the drive and failed to get involved. LESLEY'S LEGACY veered out sharply at the break, rated back off foes nearing the turn, saved ground into the lane and faded.
